

How to Calculate Your GPA

SDSU uses a 4.0 grading scale with no “pluses” or “minuses”. For instance, a student cannot receive an A– or a C+. Grades carry values as follows...

A=4 points

B=3 points

C=2 points

D=1 point

F=0 points

To calculate your Grade Points use this formula:

$$\# \text{ of credits for the class } \times \# \text{ of points for the grade} = \text{Grade Points}$$

To calculate you GPA use this formula:

$$\text{Total Grade Points divided by Total Credit Hours} = \text{GPA}$$

Sample GPA Calculation

Engl 101	3		C (2)	=	6
Math 102	3		D (1)	=	3
Soc 100	3		B (3)	=	9
GS 143	2		A (4)	=	8
Span 101	4		A (4)	=	16
	15 (total credit hours)				42 (totalgrade points)

Grad Point Average

$$42/15=2.8$$
